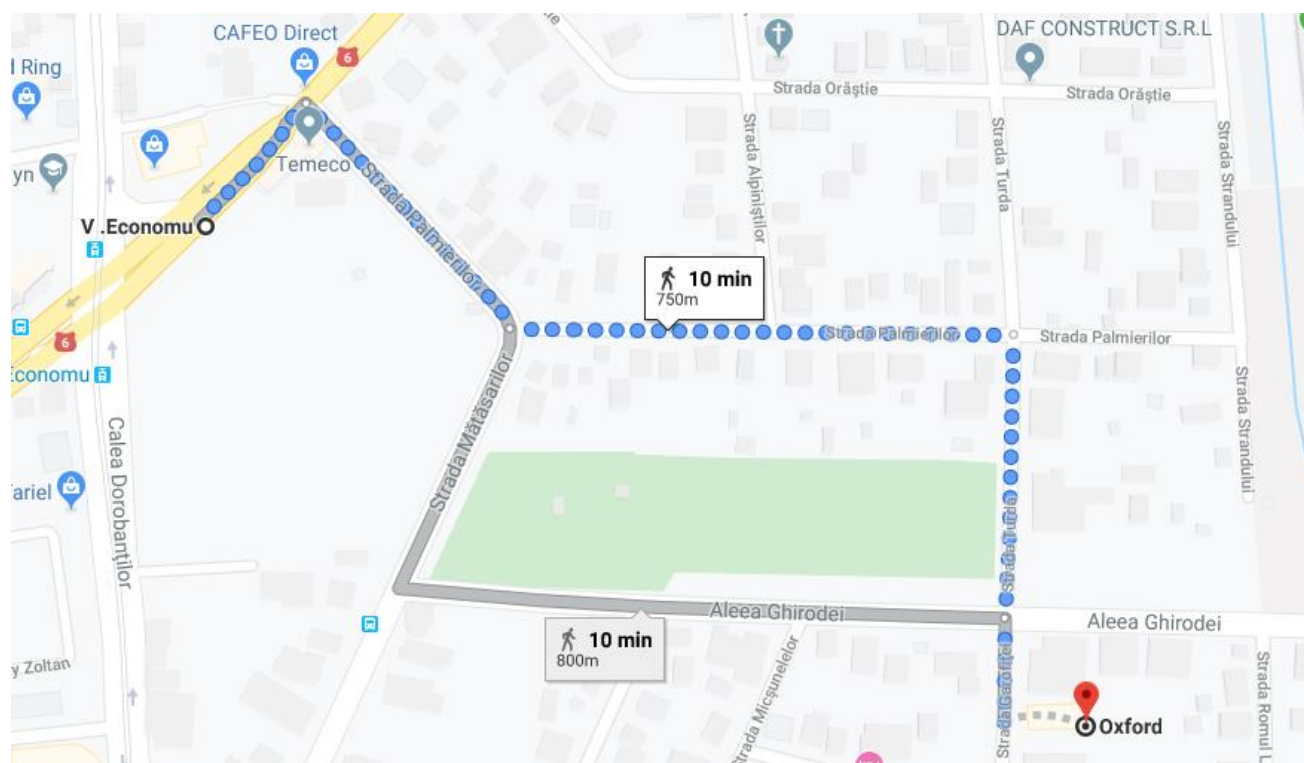
How to get to hotel “Oxford”

From Bus station and Northern train station (Gara de Nord) - Trolley Nr.11 or Tram Nr.1 to Station Piata V. Economul.

From Airport - Bus E4 to Station Piata V. Economul.

From Center - Trolley Nr. 11 or Tram Nr. 2, 10 Station Piata V. Economul.

From Station Piata V. Economul follow this map:

The domestic currency is the Romanian Leu (RON).

The exchange rate is 1 € = approx. 4,78 RON.

You can exchange foreign currency in exchange offices and banks.

Many of the banks in Romania have ATMs. Visa, Master card and other cards can be used, but always ask in advance if you plan to pay something with it.



The venue

Timisoara

Timisoara is the third largest city in the country with a population of 319,279 inhabitants and is an important historical, economic, financial, cultural and scientific center with a large community of foreigners Germans, Italians, Hungarians, Serbs. Timisoara is considered the informal capital city of the historical region of Banat. The name of the city comes from River Timis which in the ancient times the Romans used to call either Tibiscus or Tibisis.



Timisoara is also a charming place through its many parks, green spaces and public gardens that are studded with charming flowers and made people know it as “The City of Parks”. Furthermore due to its various architecture and Viennese Baroque influences, Timisoara is also called “Little Vienna”. Another extremely interesting aspect which I found fascinating (as this is about my own country) is that Timisoara was the first European city which had its streets lighted with electricity (12. November 1884). Although from a culturally point of view Timisoara has many options of entertainment, don't think there are not as many when it comes to having a good fun by enjoying going to restaurants, clubs and cafes.

Travel costs

We will reimburse **maximum of the travel costs per person as listed below** on the basis of the tickets, bus, flights etc. and the receipt of all **ORIGINAL tickets, bills, invoices, receipts, boarding tags/cards** etc.

1. Regular air tickets must be accompanied

- By the original invoice (signed and stamped)/receipt/pay order/proof of payment
- The boarding pass (the small ticket stub you receive before boarding the plane)
- The prices stated in the invoices, receipts etc. must coincide with the price on the ticket.

2. E-Tickets

- Must be printed out and include your name, the exact fare you paid, details of your flight
- Printed boarding pass for online check in (**print it twice** so one copy you can leave to us)

3. Train/Bus tickets

- It is important that that arrival and departure time as well as the price are visible



Missing or lost tickets are not reimbursed.

- Any costs for taxi are not reimbursed except taxi is only way of transport.
- We can refund travel costs done by car by rate of 0,22 € per km only in case if public transport is not possible or several participants are coming together so please contact us immediately as we need to ask European Commission from Brussels if they accept traveling by car, but we would need to justify the reasons before start of Project.
- Return tickets must be bought in advance before the journey
- Participant must travel from country of sending organization, and back.
- Following the guidelines of the Erasmus+ Programme the travel must be released by the participants on the direct way within maximum 2 days. In case of long pauses or indirect routes (holiday travel), there is no reimbursement of travel costs!
- Reimbursement is done in Euro.

Travel costs will be reimbursed during Activity 3 only if you have **original** travel tickets (or printed e-tickets) and/or invoices which you can leave to us **or** after Activity 3 finished (by bank transfer directly to bank account of your sending organization) when hosting organization receive **original** travel tickets by post, so we suggest you, when you are buying return bus, train or airplane ticket ASK for invoice too which you don't need for travel but you can leave it to us.
